Ellsworth Public Library hosts a Superb Owl Party

Forget the Super Bowl—this Saturday, EPL is all about feathered champions!

ELLSWORTH, Maine — On Saturday, February 8, from 11:00 AM to 1:30 PM, the Ellsworth Public Library will host its first-ever **Superb Owl Party**, a family-friendly event celebrating one of nature's most fascinating creatures. The library invites nature lovers of all ages to join the fun and discover what makes owls truly *superb*.

Superb Owl fans can participate in a variety of owl-themed activities, including a craft session in the Makerspace, a scavenger hunt, and an indoor nature trail for both little and not-so-little explorers.

At **12:30 PM**, Birdsacre will present a special program featuring specimens, rare photographs, and exclusive video footage—including the growth of a baby ambassador owl at Birdsacre. Due to limited space, registration is required for this portion of the event.

Birdsacre, a local nonprofit, fosters an appreciation of nature through experiential learning, inspired by Cordelia J. Stanwood. She was a pioneering naturalist, ornithologist, photographer, and writer. Birdsacre was her home.
